Dr. Rod Passman serves as the Jules J. Reingold Professor of Electrophysiology, Professor of Medicine (cardiology) and Preventive Medicine at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine. He received his medical degree from Albert Einstein College of Medicine and joined the faculty at Northwestern University in 1998 after completing his training in cardiology and cardiac electrophysiology at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania where he also completed his Master's Degree in Epidemiology and Biostatistics. Dr. Passman is the founder and Director of the Northwestern University Center for Arrhythmia Research and is a committed clinician and clinical researcher. His research is funded by the American Heart Association and National Institute of Health.
